Utility of Fraxinus Americanus and Sepia in Elimination of Uterine Fibroid - A Case Report

ABSTRACT

Uterine fibroids are tumors which develop from muscle and connective tissue in the wall of uterus. They are benign growths. They are also called as leiomyomas or myomas. Most common type of growths in woman. In this case report we will be discussing about uterine fibroid in 51years old female. She had been treated with Fraxinus Americanus Q and Sepia 200 Potency based on symptoms similarity. This is an evidenced based case report that when homoeopathy is prescribed on the basis of symptom similarity it gives wonderful results.

INTRODUCTION

Uterine fibroids are benign tumors. There are various types of uterine fibroids. They usually vary in size, shape, location usually 5 types of fibroids.1. Submucosal fibroids: They develop in myometrium between the muscle layer. They are not as common as other types.2. Pedunculated fibroids: They are like pendulous in form. They hang down with stem.3. Subserosal fibroids. They usually appear outside the uterus called as serosa. They usually grow huge in size and increase the size of uterus.4. Intramural fibroids: Most common type of fibroids. They appear within the muscular wall of uterus. they may grow large in size which occupies the uterus.5. Cervical fibroids: These are very rare. They appear on cervical region connection from uterus to vagina. This particular case is regarding intramural fibroid which is treated and resolved with usage of Fraxinus Americanus and Sepia.

CASE REPORT

A 51 years old lady presented with the history of Heavy Bleeding p/v since10-15days had reported to the clinic on 9th September 2022 with the complaints of Heavy bleeding p/v, associated with pain in abdomen, severe backache.

History of presenting complaint

Presented with the Complaints of Heavy bleeding since 10-15days, Severe pain in abdomen, backache. Bearing down sensation. Severe pain in left inguinal region radiating to lower abdomen. She is house wife, very scared towards her husband. He is an alcoholic; He beats her when he returns tonight. She feels responsible and thinks only she can take care of the family. Due to history of similar complaints regarding Heavy bleeding in past she seeked opinion of Gynaecologist, suggested for Ultrasonography which revealed Bulky uterus with? adenomyotic changes and Intramural fibroid on 23rd June 2022. She was advised for Hysterectomy. Patient was having financial crisis and she came to My OPD on 9th September 2022. She revealed the entire history, regarding the past existing complaints and also, she was having a tendency to catch cold easily. Hot sensation on scalp. Cramping pains in both lower limbs. Pain in both knee joints. Aggravated by Heavy work.

Case was taken and repertorisation was done by following Kentian method of Repertorisation, Sepia 200 was selected based on the symptom similarity. Sepia is having very characteristic feature acting on uterine affections. Fraxinus americanus q indicated 10drops in the morning and night for 2months.
