COVID-19: Challenges Facing in Online Learning by Students in Rural Areas; The Case Study in Nandurbar District

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ABSTRACT

At the beginning of year 2020 and ending of December 2019 an outbreak of a novel Corona virus that is COVID-19 find out in Wuhan City (China). It was propagating fast in few months in all over countries. In this situation Government implemented various phase of lockdown in the country. Very bad impact happened to lockdown on educational institutions, schools and colleges and exams. They could not start their academic year at right time. Maharashtra Government declared their decision on all education departments to start an academic schedule in online mode. Due to this all student in rural areas in Nandurbar district (Maharashtra state, India) are facing unexpected challenges to online learn during the period of lockdown. Against this condition with the help of quantitative analysis in this paper expressed various types of challenges to online learn faced by students in rural areas. Our study mainly focused on difficulties of online learning and analysis their challenges faced by students. 
MATERIAL & METHOD

Through online survey we found many challenges faced by students.


Do you think difficult to accept online learning?




According to our survey, 53.8 per cent students found difficult to adapt the online learning environment immediately after the traditional classroom learning environment, 42.9 per cent students feel difficult to adapt and only 3.3 per cent students are in neutral position.

57.1 per cent students are not well connected with best internet connection with online learning. 38.2 students experienced some times poor connectivity and downloading subject wise information i.e. video, pdf etc. and 04.7 per cent students not face technical issues in online learning.




Do you face problems to handle educational app Zoom, Google meet etc.?




28.9 per cent students have poor technical skill or not comfortable with online learning, 59.8 per cent students faced this difficulty some times and 11.3 per cent students are neutral.

34.2 per cent students face difficulties to manage their time for online learning, 54.5 per cent students faced this problem in some times & 11.3 per cent students are neutral.




Do you feel lack of motivation during online class?





47.8 per cent students facing disturbance at home for online learning and 36.2 per cent students facing some times this problem and 15.9 per cent students are neutral.




Do you want some period to accept online learning?




62.1 per cent students feels difficulty to complete learning assignment to online class and 31.6 per cent students faces not this difficulty and 6.3 per cent students can't say such think.


Can you clear all doubt of subject during online learning?
